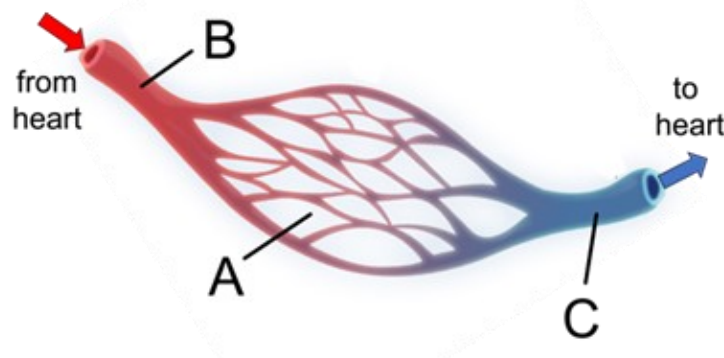

- A = Capillary, B = Artery, C = Vein

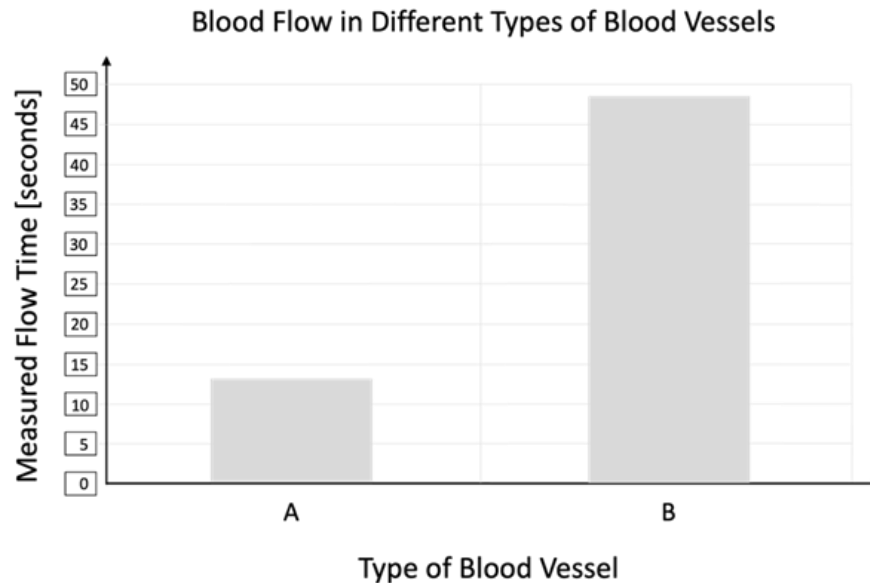
