After searching the Science Buddies website he was inspired by the Project Idea Which Wing Design Creates the Greatest Lift. When he discovered "camber" a term with which he wasn't familiar, he began to research this term and its relation to flight and aerodynamics. He was so fascinated by what he found that he developed his own unique project "Airfoil Efficiency as Determined by Camber".

With hard work and help from his experienced teachers, Justin had great success at his regional fair, the Contra



Costa County Science and Engineering Fair. He went home with a 1<sup>st</sup> Place Category Award, the Grand Award, and the Best in Show Award in addition to the Hoover Young Engineer Award and the 2<sup>nd</sup> Place Award from the Northern California Chapter of the American Vacuum Society. His success at the regional level earned him a spot at the 2007 Intel International Science and Engineering Fair (ISEF). Justin enjoyed his experience at Intel ISEF 2007 feels it was "an award in itself to be one of the 1,500 competing students."

Justin will attend U.C. Davis next year and plans to major in Aeronautical Engineering. In addition to doing research about his chosen field of study Justin enjoys reading, spending time with friends a family, and following NASA missions.
